- 5. Medal & a Certificate to be given.

3.BUDDING PROSTHO- STAR (PG-student)

- 1. The Post-graduate should be student member of National and regional IPS Branch.
- 2. Should have participated in at least **one IPS conference** (National conference/PG convention/regional branch conference).
- 3. Applicant should be in MDS third year / entered 3rd year student.
- 4. Should submit 5 original cases done in the department of prosthodontics under the following categories
 - a. Implant placement
 - b. Maxillo-Facial Prosthesis

- c. Esthetic Restorations
- d. Full Mouth Occlusal rehabilitations
- e. Special Case of Interest.
- 5. The scanned copy of the college case sheets along with radiographs/ pre and post-operative images (with a brief case report of the submitted cases attested by the head of the department).
- 6. The bonafide certificate signed by the Head, Dept of Prosthodontics with his regional branch registration number and IPS number(OL Number).
- Additional points if they have presented /won in the paper /poster category of scientific sessions in the subject of prosthodontics at IPS Conference/PG Conventions (According to the Score Sheet Template)
- 8. Publications will carry additional points
- 9. Appearance & clearing IBP Part 1 exams will carry additional marks

4.PROSTHO-STAR

- 1. The nominee should be a Member of National and regional IPS branch.
- 2. Should *not be more than five years* after completion of MDS.
- 3. Should have participated in at least **3** *IPS conferences* (National conference/PG convention/regional branch conference).
- 4. Candidate should be a faculty member of a teaching institute.
- 5. Should not have received the above mentioned award in the previous years in the same category
- 6. The selection of candidate will be decided based on the points received under the following:
 - a. Each IPS conference or convention participated will receive one point.
 - b. Presentations at the IPS conference and Convention after MDS will receive 1 point for each presentation
 - c. Awards in conference presentations post MDS will receive two points each.
 - d. Publications in indexed journals.
 - i. PubMed: 3 points
 - ii. Scopus: 2 points
 - iii. Web of Science: 1 point

5.PROSTHO WIZARD

- 1. The nominee should be a member of IPS National and regional branch(if applicable)
- 2. Should have completed *five years and not more than 10 years after post-graduation*
- 3. Candidate should be a faculty member of a teaching institute.
- 4. Should have participated in at least *4 IPS conferences* (National conference/PG convention/regional branch conference).
- 5. Should not have received the above mentioned award in the previous years in the same category
- 6. The selection of candidate will be decided based on the points received under the following:
 - a. Each IPS conference or convention participated after master's degree will receive one point.
 - b. Presentations at the IPS conference and Convention after MDS will receive 1 point for each presentation
 - c. Awards in conference presentations post MDS will receive two points each.
 - d. Publications after master's degree in indexed journals.
 - i. PubMed: 3 points
 - ii. Scopus: 2 points
 - iii. Web of Science: 1 point

- 1. The nominee should be a member of IPS National and regional branch(if applicable)
- 2. Should have completed *more than 10 years* after post-graduation
- 3. Candidate should be a faculty member of a teaching institute.
- 4. Should have participated in at least *6 IPS conferences* (National conference/PG convention/regional branch conference).
- 5. Should not have received any of the above mention award in the previous years in the same category
- 6. The selection of candidate will be decided based on the points received under the following:
 - a. Each IPS conference or convention participated after master's degree will receive one point.
 - b. Presentations at the IPS conference and Convention after MDS will receive 1 point for each presentation
 - c. Awards in conference presentations post MDS will receive two points each.
 - d. Publications after master's degree in indexed journals.
 - i. PubMed: 3 points
 - ii. Scopus: 2 points
 - iii. Web of Science: 1 point
 - e. Course coordinators for PCC in IPS conferences/conventions.
 - f. Funded research will receive two points each.
 - a. Patents will receive two points each.
 - b. Member as a IPS Conference / Convention Organising Committee.
 - g. Indian Board of Prosthodontics
 - i. Passed 1st part: 2 points
 - ii. IBP board member: 4 points
- 7. Soft copies of all supporting documents to be uploaded with self-attestation along with the application.

7.EXCEPTIONAL PROSTHO-CLINICIAN

- 1. The clinicians should not be attached in any institutions.
- 2. Should be a member of IPS National and regional branch(if applicable)
- 3. Should have completed more than 5 years after post-graduation

- 4. Should have participated in at least *4 IPS conferences* (National conference/PG convention/regional conference).
- 5. Should present 5 original cases done in prosthodontics under the following categories
 - a. Implants
 - b. Maxillo-Facial Prosthesis
 - c. Esthetic Restorations
 - d. Occlusal rehabilitations
- 6. If received an award in this category once, is eligible to apply in the same only after completion of 4 years of receiving the award
- 7. Should submit a clear bio data of their clinical expertise and experiences.
- **8.** Not applicable for IBP diplomates.

- **1.** The documents to be attached.
 - a. Your short resume
 - b. Publications
 - c. Cases required for those category.(Photographs of good resolution, Pre & postoperative Radiographs, Pre & Post-operative Pictures with clear legends only will be considered).
 - d. Conference attendance certificates and other relevant certificates
- 2. In case a State has more than one regional branch, individual regional branches can give award among colleges in that region and/or join together and give an award for the entire state.
- 3. All applications will be addressed to the Regional Branch Secretary. The EC of the branch will appoint a scrutinising committee and will decide the winners.
